

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 107

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEDERLAND, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 107 WHICH REGULATES TRAFFIC UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF NEDERLAND, ADDING STOP SIGNS AT AVENUE D AT 23rd STREET, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Nederland is of the opinion that traffic control is required in order to properly regulate traffic and maintain safety on the roads and streets of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Nederland originally approved an amendment to Ordinance 107 on June 12, 1961; the City Council proposes to add stops signs on Avenue D at 23rd Street and

WHEREAS, the Nederland Police Department received a request to add stops on Avenue D at 23rd Street, making the intersections a 4-way stop, due to speeding along Ave D, making the intersection a 4-way stop, due to previous traffic accidents and lack of traffic control at this intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEDERLAND, TEXAS THAT:

Ordinance No. 107 is hereby amended by adding the following language:

ARTICLE VII.

SECTION 54.1 – STOP SIGNS

The intersections at Avenue D at 23rd Street, shall be designated as a "4-Way Stop Intersection". Stop signs shall be erected and maintained at all four corners in accordance with local and state law. All vehicles must come to a complete stop before entering the intersection.

ARTICLE XVI.

SECTION 122 – PENALTY


Any person who intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly violates any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall on conviction thereof be fined as provided in Sec. 102-323, Nederland Code of Ordinances.

ARTICLE XVII.

SECTION 133 – EFFECTIVE DATE

This amendment to the ordinance shall be in full force and effect after publication as provided by law.
